About Victoria Park Pool

Victoria Park Pool includes a heated 8 lane 50 metre lap swimming pool, alongside it is a splash pool for toddlers, featuring a 'beach'-style entry deck. The centre also offers as a cardio and weights fitness gym, as well as a group fitness room for timetabled classes.

Victoria Park Pool also has a crèche which is open at different times during the week, please contact the centre to confirm times.

Getting to Victoria Park Pool

Public transport

There are several buses that stop next to or are in close walking distance from Victoria Park Pool. This includes many buses that travel both from the CBD towards the Inner West area, and from the Inner West towards the CBD which stop within 100 metres of the entrance on Parramatta Road. There are also several buses that stop within a 200 metre walk from Victoria Park Pool on City Road, travelling towards the Newtown area from the CBD and vice versa.

The closest train station to Victoria Park Pool is Redfern Train Station which is a 20-minute walk away.

Driving or parking

There is no on-site dedicated car park for Victoria Park Pool, though there is a public car park within Victoria Park with access from City Road, travelling from Newtown side, which is 150 metres from the entrance to the centre. This provides free 2 hour parking. There is also street parking in the surrounding area, which at times is a clearway so please check signs.

There are 2 disabled parking spaces at the entrance of Victoria Park Pool, access to these are via City Road from Newtown side or from Parramatta Road travelling away from the CBD.

Taxis and private vehicles

There is no designated set down area for taxis and private vehicles at Victoria Park Pool, though it is possible for taxi drop offs within the public car park within Victoria Park, entrance to this is via City Road travelling from Newtown towards the CBD.

Entrance

The pathway to the main pedestrian entrance includes a shallow decline from the footpath at both City Road and Parramatta Road towards the entrance of Victoria Park Pool. These pathways are tarmacked, but not totally smooth. The entrance is via one step or there is a ramped kerbed section for ease of accessibility. Entry is via 1 in swinging glass door.

Customer service

Victoria Park Pool reception desk is directly in front of the entrance. The desk is at a suitable height for wheelchair accessibility.

Toilets and change room facilities

There are 1 set of male and 1 set of female changing rooms and toilets available at Victoria Park Pool. The male toilets and change rooms are to the left once past reception, along the walkway past the gym and before the lockers. The female changing rooms and toilets are to the right once past reception and past the café.

There are also 4 unisex family rooms and accessible change rooms and bathroom facilities at the centre. 3 of these are located by turning left once past reception next to the male changing rooms. 1 is located by turning right past reception and is at the end of the corridor past the café, next to the female changing rooms.

Lifts, stairs and passageways

There are no lifts at Victoria Park Pool. There are a small set of stairs that lead from the male and female changing rooms to the pool deck. There are also ramps that lead from the changing rooms for easy accessibility and for those that may find the stairs difficult.

There is a 30cm blocked lip on the edge of the pool. There is an inclined ramp at the shallow end of the pool for ease of accessibility for those that may find the 30cm blocked difficult to manoeuvre.

If required there is a mobility ladder and accessibility hoist situated in the shallow end of the 50-metre lap swimming pool. Please notify staff if you require assistance in accessing the pool with the aid of the hoist.

Audio communication

There is no hearing loop available at Victoria Park Pool.
